ELIGIBILITY

This award is open to female financial professionals in any speciality who provided services during the 2023 calendar year. Candidates can self-nominate or be nominated by others.

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Submissions will be evaluated based on responses to the following criteria, with a maximum of 300 words per criteria:

- Exceptional Contributions: Describe the exceptional contributions you have made to the financial advice industry, highlighting specific initiatives, projects, or achievements that have had a significant impact.
- Leadership and Innovation: Demonstrate your leadership and innovation within the financial services field. Provide examples of how you have led teams, introduced innovative practices, or driven change within your organisation or the industry.
- Mentorship and Support: Illustrate how you have actively mentored and supported other women in the industry. Include details of mentoring programs, networking initiatives, or other activities aimed at fostering the development of female professionals.
- Commitment to Excellence: Show how you have consistently demonstrated excellence in your professional conduct and performance, serving as a role model for others in the financial services industry.
